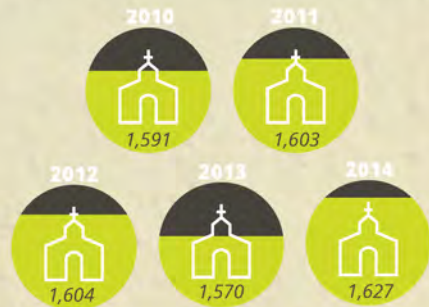

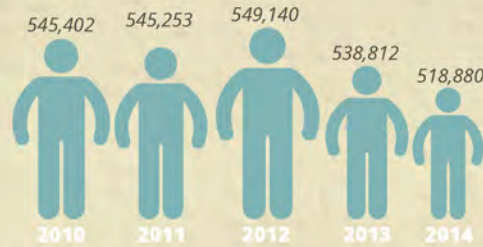

What happened in 2014?

Evangelism Conference
Approximate attendance 1,000; personal care items were distributed to Angola inmates. (Shortened this year to 1 day due to ice)

Keyboard Festivals
593 students participated from 100 different churches

CEC
675 students from 23 campuses participated

Kaleidoscope
204 women attended from 53 churches

Voyage
99 youth came from 11 churches

M-Jam
798 registered from 58 churches

RA Congress
202 young men from 17 churches participated; 16 of the participants indicated they prayed to receive Christ - 3 baptisms & 19 rededications

WMU Missions Celebration & Annual Meeting
230 ladies participated from 57 churches

Bible Drill
60 churches; 489 children, 121 youth participated (77 High School - & 10 for Speaker's Tournament)

RA Camp
65 campers attended; 13 made professions of faith; 2 rededications

Clear Camps
3 weeks of camp; over 980 participants and 63 students made decisions to follow Christ

Girls Mission Camp
228 GA's from 25 churches; 11 made decisions for Christ - 1 rededication; 1 surrendered for mission service

All-State Youth Choir
78 singers from 38 churches

PreTeen Invasion
Over 1300 preteens; 35 made decisions to follow Christ

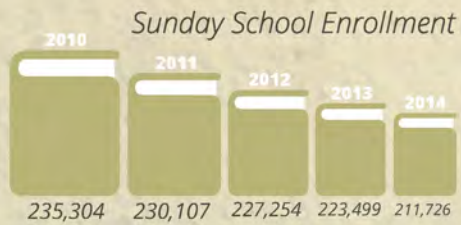
E4 Conference

674 registered messengers from 291 congregations

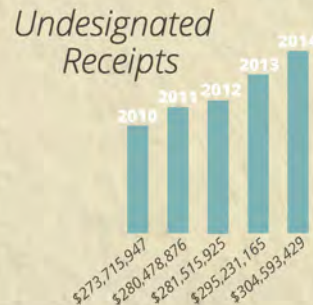
YEC

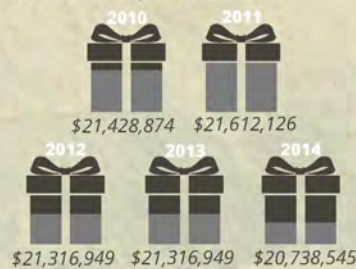

CP% of Undesignated Receipts



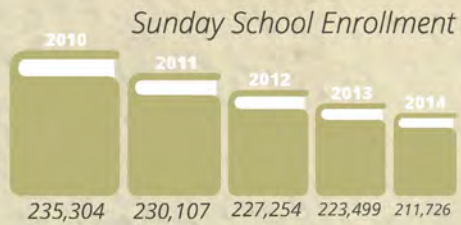
Total CP Gifts Received



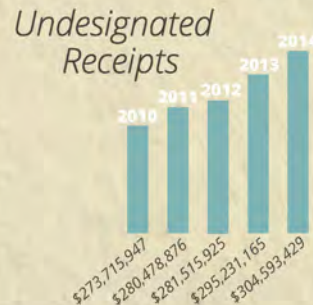

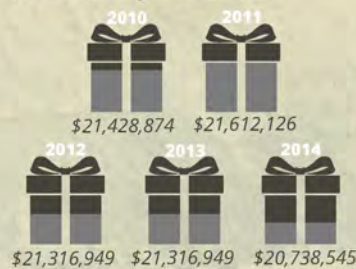
