While You Are Here

Flexibility is key. Please bring a “*whatever it takes*” attitude with you.

Plan to **work full days**

Take time to **listen** to homeowners and community residents with an open heart. Let them tell their story.

DO NOT make promises that **you** personally cannot or will not keep.

Be courteous to other volunteers.

- Respect the privacy and property of others.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm until 6:00 am
- Help keep the living area clean. Pick up trash and put it away
- Keep luggage to a minimum, storage space is limited.
- The use of profanity will not be tolerated.

The use or possession of **alcohol and illegal drugs are not permitted**.

The housing locations and worksites are **TOBACCO-FREE** (in all forms).

Groups must arrive before 6:30 pm. Housing facilities **close at 10 pm** and **reopen at 6 am**. Make arrangements with the Site Coordinator if you must arrive or depart during these hours.

Meals are on your own. It is unlikely you will have access to a kitchen, bring coolers to keep breakfast and lunch items cold and plan to eat dinner in a local restaurant.

Gracefully receive Thank you’s from the community, Let them express appreciation for all those who are here and have been here before you.

Treat everyone with respect, love and grace

Be courteous to staff and volunteers

- Respect camp “lights out” and “quiet hour” schedules
- Wipe mud off your shoes when entering the building.
- Please leave the shower area neater and cleaner than you found it.
- Take ALL of your personal items and clothing with you after your shower – items left behind are subject to disposal.
- Keep shower times short – others are waiting.
- Clean your sleeping area daily by removing garbage
- Prior to your departure, bag all your trash and carry it to the dumpster. **PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF!**
- Absolutely no food or drink in sleeping quarters!
