This means **more photos, videos, and written statuses.** Although it may be tempting to constantly post web links, Facebook will limit how many people see them.

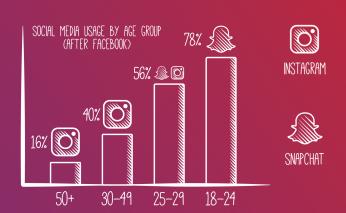

## KNOW YOUR AUDIENCE

According to Pew Research, Facebook is still king of social media. However, **Snapchat and Instagram** are much more popular among teenagers and young adults. Who you are directing your message to may determine which platform you use.

## SCHEDULE YOUR POSTING Don't let social media stress you out. Plan your posts out in advance. Online services, such as **Buffer.com** (which is free, by the way) allow you to create an online calendar.
