Subject: Fiscal Year 2019 Nonprofit Security Grant Program

FEMA will release the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) no later than April 16, 2019. The total award for FY 2019 NSGP will be \$60 million.

The Grant Programs Directorate (GPD) is encouraging State Administrative Agencies (SAAs) and Urban Area Working Groups (UAWGs) to begin planning now for the release of the FY 2019 NSGP Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) by:

1. Conducting outreach to the nonprofit community in your state/territory to spread the word on the availability of funding and to encourage nonprofits to apply.
2. Reviewing SAA responsibilities for the program as outlined in the FY 2018 NSGP NOFO. GPD anticipates that the FY 2019 NOFO will be similar to that of FY 2018.
3. Reviewing or developing processes to support the NSGP application submission and review process.

SAA responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

Before the NOFO is released:

- Conducting outreach to the nonprofit community in your state/territory to spread the word on the availability of funding and to encourage nonprofits to apply

Immediately after the NOFO is released:

- Establish an application deadline for nonprofit organizations that is: prior to the SAA deadline identified by FEMA in the FY 2019 NSGP NOFO and that gives the SAA enough time to review and score applications;
- Disseminate this deadline and any additional SAA requirements for nonprofit organizations promptly and widely.

After the SAA deadline closes:

- Review, score, and prioritize, nonprofit organization applications using the guidance that will be provided in the FY 2019 NSGP NOFO.

SAVE THE DATE:

GPD is planning a webinar on Wednesday, March 20th, 2019 at 2PM ET to provide SAAs additional guidance on NSGP outreach to the nonprofit community. This will be a great

opportunity to ask questions and share information. GPD will send an invite and additional details for the webinar once finalized.
