PLAN OF SALVATION

- Drill Leader:** "What does the Bible teach us about sin?"  
**Answer:** "All of us have sinned. Romans 3:23 tells us 'For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.'"
- Drill Leader:** "Will our good works save us?"  
**Answer:** "We cannot save ourselves. Ephesians 2:8 tells us 'For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God's gift—"
- Drill Leader:** "To whom must we go to be saved?"  
**Answer:** "We must go to Jesus. John 6:37b tells us 'and the one who comes to me I will never cast out.'"
- Drill Leader:** "Is it necessary that we must repent?"  
**Answer:** "We must be sorry for our sins and turn away from them. Luke 13:5 tells us 'No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all perish as well!.'"
- Drill Leader:** "In whom should we place our trust?"  
**Answer:** "We must trust Jesus to save us. Acts 16:31 tells us 'They said, 'Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household.'"
