- **IMB announced that 1,100 people** are currently in the missionary pipeline, exploring opportunities to serve overseas, up from only 300 four years ago.
- IMB missionary Travis Burkhalter baptized the first known believer among one of the Embera people groups in South America.
- Through food distribution in South Asia, IMB missionaries led an entire family to the Lord. This family now attends church regularly and is hosting weekly Bible study and prayer in their home.

- Send Relief Serve Tours in Dayton, Ohio and Jacksonville, Fla., saw 106 churches and more than 1,400 volunteers participate. Over 5,700 people were served and 700 of those were engaged in gospel conversations.
- About 500 chaplains participated in an evangelism training retreat held at Ridgecrest Conference Center in North Carolina.
- The GenSend team hosted 150 youth leaders during their Youth Leader Coaching Network and roughly 500 people attended a webinar that equipped youth leaders

in how to address controversial cultural topics through a biblical worldview.
