- Sixty-two missionaries were commissioned during the February IMB Trustee meeting in Phoenix.
- The IMB renewed its commitment to connect rural U.S. churches with IMB personnel through the Global Rural Network. There are an estimated 3.7 billion rural peoples.

- The Send Relief Serve Tour event in Augusta, Georgia drew 770 volunteers from 65 churches.
 Their 35 projects resulted in 540 gospel presentations, and 24 reported salvations.
- In Dallas, the Send Relief Serve Tour united 48 churc hes to serve across a variety of compassion projects. Their efforts resulted in 520 gospel conversations and 43 reported salvations.
- NAMB's Evangelism Trainings in the first quarter resulted in more than 2,150 ministry leaders receiving training in how to develop a culture of evangelism in their church or ministry.

 The Woodlake Addiction and Recovery Ministry had their largest worship service of the year in March. Nine people made a profession of faith and many more came for prayer and recommitment.



- The first ever Teen Girl Retreat took place at Clara Springs Camp in March. Over 232 teenage girls and sponsors attended and focused on integrating coping skills with Biblical truth.
- Here for You, Louisiana Baptists' multimedia outreach strategy, generated 469 views of the Gospel presentation and 67 indicated decisions for Christ through our partnership with the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association. In addition, there were 140 searches for area churches.
